Again, I thank you all for coming out and being a part of this special day and I look forward to seeing you at the next GOTV with the Greater Houston Council of Federated Republican Women.

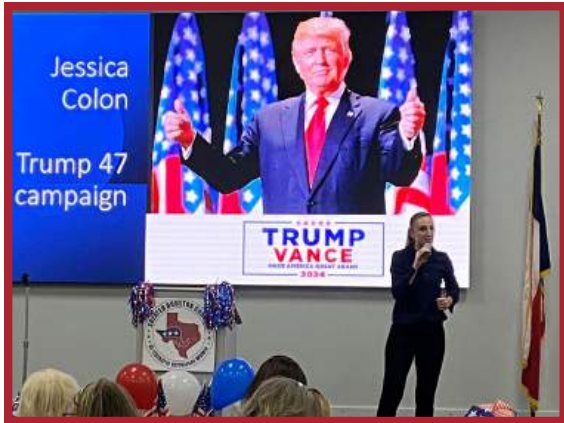

GHCFRW Meeting Minutes

May 14, 2024

Ronnye Cowell, Recording Secretary



President, Tina Gibson called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM.

The opening prayer and pledges were led by Chaplain, Alicia Cantrell.

First Vice President Buckley Morlot introduced elected officials and candidates.

RNC Committeewoman candidate Debbie Georgatos spoke about her candidacy and invited members to visit with her after the meeting.

John Wenske gave an update on the status of Senator Cruz's campaign.

GHC members running for RNC National delegates spoke briefly about running during the Congressional Caucus at the upcoming RPT convention next week in San Antonio.

Buckley Morlot introduced Bergundi Cain. Bergundi spoke about her journey of involvement with Republican Women's Clubs in Texas. She helped start Baytown RW and admits there were mistakes made along the way, but the process works, and the club is strong. When getting new members in your clubs, it is important to reach out to them and give them a mentor. It is also important to "build a bench" for people behind you to move up into leadership roles. The most important things for us to do is show up and volunteer. Everyone has different skill sets and those skill sets need to be identified and utilized to make clubs successful.

Hospitality Chair Joyce Chambers thanked Brazosport RW and Memorial West RW for providing breakfast and snacks for this morning's meeting.

VP of Membership Amy Byers, called the roll of Member Clubs and confirmed there was a quorum of Members Clubs present. We have 2 new TFRW Chartered clubs in our area. They are Liberty City RW and Nancy Hart RW. Amy reminded us to not be a "Debbie Downer" and to keep clubs positive by uplifting those around you. Make your clubs be a place where people want to go.

Recording Secretary Ronnye Cowell presented the minutes from the last meeting and asked for any corrections or additions. None were made and Sophia Mafrige made a motion to accept the minutes as written. It was seconded by Joyce Chambers and passed unanimously.

President Tina Gibson spoke about upcoming summer activities for Republicans and GHC. She mentioned at convention, we will elect a Presidential Elector in our Congressional Caucuses and they will run like other candidates at the RPT Convention. GHC will have an ad in the convention program which will have a QR code for people to scan linking them to our website where they can find information about the upcoming September 7th Special Event.

GHC 3rd Vice President and Chair of the Special Event, Dana Kahn, reminded everyone to "save the date" for the "Take Flight Gala" to take place on Saturday, September 7th at the Lone Star Flight Museum. A reception will be held at 6:00 PM and the event will begin at 7:00 PM. Sponsor information was sent out to GHC member club Presidents last night. SJ Swanson pointed out there will be opportunities for ads and that tables have already been sold. Sophia Mafrige explained the sponsorship levels and the "plane names" that accompany them. Each table will have 10 seats. The Greater Houston Council Patriot Award will also be given out during this event. Steve Munisteri will help with that presentation as a past recipient. Renee Lunsford, Legislation Chair, gave a brief update on RPT Convention and discussed the platform and priorities. She discussed what positions will be elected at the convention. She reminded members that TFRW is helping with compensation for members attending the convention this year to give back to members. Thursday evening TFRW is sponsoring an event at the Alamo with guest speaker Land Commissioner Dawn Buckingham. Friday evening, they are holding a gala event and will be honoring Texas 1st Lady Cecelia Abbott. She then gave members hints on what items they need to make sure to pack and carry with them during meetings and caucuses in the convention center.

Nuts 'n Bolts Co-chairs Amy Byers and Betsy Kindred asked for suggestions for next year. They apologized for the snafus in the 2nd room. They want things to run as smoothly as possible and will try to work out those kinks for next year's event. We had a good turnout and hopefully everyone who attended got some good ideas to take back to your clubs. All information from the thumb drive is available on the website which is password protected. 141 people attended. Amy and Betsy want not only TFRW presenter, but local leaders, as well to present at Nuts 'n Bolts.

Elizabeth Walker, GOTV Rally Chair, said the date for the rally is August 27th . It will be held from 9:00 – 1:00. She is compiling a list of key candidates and keynote speaker for the event as we celebrate our 62nd anniversary year. She plans to have a fun song like the one we had in 2022. We are covering the GHC southeast Texas counties. There were around 200 in attendance at the last event and there were several statewide candidates. We will have a boxed lunch. The booklet given to all attendees will have all candidates listed for surrounding counties and statewide offices.

Tina Gibson gave the report for President's Liaison Marga Mathews who was not able to be present today. There will be a luncheon for club Presidents to help mentor each other. That date will be set in July.

Campaign Activities Chair Gayla Baker encouraged members to be sure to turn in hours and calls to TFRW. She knows everyone has many hours to report during this busy election season.

Hospitality Chair Joyce Chambers thanked the clubs again who brought refreshments for today. She will need more clubs to volunteer for our next meeting on September 17th.

Alicia Cantrell is a member of the Women's Leadership Forum for the NRA. They will be teaming up for a concealed handgun license class July 27 th at the Texas Gun Club in Stafford.

President Gibson then asked for announcements. Members shared events and activities coming up with their clubs.

They will also be holding a Trump Caravan from League City to Galveston which will end in a Rally. The cost is \$20 per participant. 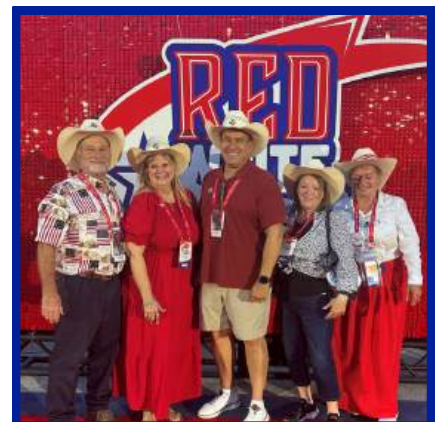
